

Is Albania's energy situation good or bad?

Albania produces almost all of its electricity through hydropower plants, and then during the winter, imports the deficit in fossil fuel energy from neighbouring countries. But the situation is not looking suitable for the months ahead. "We are currently seeing it, there is no rain, the sky is shining from the sun. The news is bad," Rama said.
