

Can a rechargeable battery be inserted into a base station?

What should I do if my SimpliSafe battery is bad?

Your SimpliSafe Base Station is fitted with NiMH rechargeable batteries, which are constantly recharging as long as the Base Station is plugged in. If you are seeing a "Power Outage" warning, you'll want to check if there is power at your location, and that the Base Station is properly connected to AC (for example, check that it hasn't been unplugged accidentally!).

The lead acid batteries are only good for a few years before they need replaced. One of the UPS companies makes a lithium battery UPS with a DC output that would probably last a long time meant for powering routers and such. It's pricey though, only benefits would be not having to disassemble the unit to swap batteries, and no downtime swapping ...

Personally I wouldn't keep them in the base station, I'll explain myself: Me and some other people's base station completely bricked while hot swapping batteries. The base station goes completely dark and then just never turns on ...

The base station speaker wakes me up at 3AM to tell me camera battery is low. How do I turn this feature off?? What's worse, the camera it's referencing is offline and not even in use. Simplisafe, please give us a "do not disturb" or base station voice mode off option. Giving me camera batter updates at 3AM is not appreciated.
