

How do I know if my car battery is dead?

Signs of a dead or dying battery include difficulty starting your car, dim headlights, a battery light on your dashboard, and a battery that's old, leaking, corroded, or swollen. Jumpstart your car to recharge a dead battery. If it still won't start or dies soon after starting, replace the battery or have a mechanic check the electrical system.

Why do batteries appear to die suddenly?

Batteries can appear to die suddenly because today's engines are more sophisticated than they were 30 years ago. They're smaller, lighter and easier to start than your grandparents' cars were back in the day. Today's cars can compensate for a dying battery (but not fully recharge it.) On one hand, that compensation is good news.

What does a dead car battery mean?

Often, a "dead car battery" simply means that it's fully discharged and the voltage is below functional 12V. You can jump-start the dead vehicle and drive it to let the alternator replenish the battery charge. Alternatively, you can attach the dead battery to a battery charger.

What happens if a car battery dies?

With a failing battery, you'll notice that the engine cranks more slowly than usual, and the car takes longer to start. You'll often only get one or two warning signs of this nature before the battery completely dies, so don't ignore it. If, when turning the key, you hear a clicking sound, there is not enough power to crank the engine at all.

How do I know if my car battery is corroded?

Your car battery is visibly corroded. You might notice a fluffy, blue coating on the positive terminal or/and a clear film on your battery casing. The battery warning light illuminates on your dashboard. If this light illuminates while you are driving, you are likely to have a battery fault or failing alternator.

Why is my car battery dead?

Car batteries actually need maintenance to have a long life. This includes cleaning the terminals, filling with battery water (if the battery has this refilling holes), and maintaining recharge your car battery quite often.
