

How much does electric car battery replacement cost in the UK?

The average cost to replace the battery in an electric car in the UK can range from £3,000 to £8,000, depending on the make and model of the vehicle. How often do electric car batteries need to be replaced?

Tesla battery replacement costs can vary widely by model. For example, replacing a Model S battery may set you back between \$12,000 to \$15,500, while the Model 3 might run you up to \$28,000 for a total replacement. The Model X generally exceeds \$13,900 in total costs, and Model Y replacements range from

\$10,500 to \$11,400.
