Can a 12V battery charger be used on a 72V battery pack?

You can get 72V battery chargers, but they tend to be expensive and bulky. By using individual 12V chargers for each battery you also ensure that each battery is charged to its full capacity, so the pack remains balanced. Nice topic can i use 6x 12v cargers to use on my 72v pack .

Can a 12V battery be charged with a 48V Charger?

Listen they are batteries and yes you need to be very careful not to cross wire as this will short the battery. However you can charge 48v with a 12v chargerit will just take a lot longer also the slower you charge your battery the more life you will get out of it charging at a high rate does damage battery faster less life on battery.

Can You charge a 12V battery side by side?

The good news is that with the right type of charger you can connect several smaller chargers side by side(in series) to give the voltage you need. On my motorcycle I have five small 12V chargers underneath the seat,each of which charges a 12V battery in a 60V series string.
