

# China Building Solar Power Generation Project

Will China build a 'solar Great Wall'?

China is building a vast 'Solar Great Wall' -- and it's set to power Beijing. The project, expected to be finished in 2030, will be 400 kilometers (250 miles) long, 5 kilometers (3 miles) wide, and achieve a maximum generating capacity of 100 gigawatts.

How big is China's solar power project?

Expected to be completed by 2030, the project will span 250 miles in length and 3 miles in width, with a maximum capacity of 100 gigawatts. China's rapid expansion of solar power is a significant step in addressing global climate challenges.

How much solar power will China produce in 2024?

By June 2024, China accounted for 51 percent of the world's solar farm capacity, leading the globe in renewable energy generation, according to Global Energy Monitor's (GEM) Global Solar Power Tracker. The Kubuqi project alone is expected to produce 180 billion kilowatt-hours (kWh) annually by 2030, enough to power Beijing and beyond.

Are solar projects causing the greening of deserts in China?

Analysis of Landsat data indicates that solar projects have contributed to the greening of deserts in other parts of China in recent years. As of June 2024, China led the world in operating solar farm capacity with 386,875 megawatts, representing about 51 percent of the global total, according to Global Energy Monitor's Global Solar Power Tracker.

What is the largest solar power project in the world?
