

How do you remove a laptop battery?

On some laptops, the battery pops out on its own. On others, you must pull the battery out gently with the tips of your fingers. Although most laptops only have one latch, there are some that require you to slide two latches to remove the battery.

How do I replace a laptop battery?

If you are replacing a laptop battery, insert the new battery after removing the old battery. If your laptop is plugged in, either unplug it or disconnect the power cable. Turn your laptop over so the bottom is facing up. Locate the battery latch on the bottom of the laptop. The image above shows some common battery latches found on laptops.
