How should lithium batteries be packaged?

When preparing shipments containing lithium batteries, it is important to ensure the batteries are not in any way defective, damaged, or have the potential to produce a dangerous evolution of heat, fire or short circuit. When packaging lithium batteries for shipment, strong rigid outer packaging must be used.

How do I post a lithium battery?

When posting lithium batteries by ground or by air, you must take account of the UN3481 regulations as detailed above. Make sure your lithium battery is contained in its associated device. Seal the on/off switches and any electrical terminals with tape. Place your device in a plastic bag before packaging it.

The lithium content cannot exceed 1 gram/20 Wh or 2 gram/100 Wh per battery. Batteries must be packed to protect them from heating, short circuit and to prevent any crush. Batteries must not be damaged or defective. Identifying ...

Lithium batteries (or equipment containing lithium batteries) are a dangerous good and present a fire and safety risk if carried incorrectly. As a result there are certain limitations around how they can be sent by Australia Post. Lithium batteries are of two general types: Lithium Ion (rechargeable) and Lithium Metal (non-rechargeable).

Lithium batteries power many of the devices we rely on every day, from smartphones and laptops to electric bikes and medical equipment. But when it comes to shipping these batteries, a common question arises: Can ...

Note. Effective July 1, 2015, all existing customers and new customers who wish to ship lithium metal batteries without equipment (UN3090) via UPS &#174; Air services must obtain pre-approval from UPS Airlines. This requirement is to ensure that proper training has occurred and that all applicable safety regulations are properly followed for such shipments.
