

How to unplug the car battery and plug it back in

How to plug a car battery back into the vehicle?

Once you are ready, it is time to plug the battery back into the vehicle. In this scenario, you should always start with the positive terminal. Place it over the positive battery post and secure it with the nut. Then do the same with the negative terminal. After reconnecting the battery, make sure all connections are secure.

How do you remove a car battery?

If you want to completely disconnect the battery, for replacement, charging or storage somewhere safe, undo the clamp on the positive side and stow the cable out of the way. Disconnect the positive To remove the battery, release any retaining straps or anchors that hold the battery in, and lift it out of the car.

Always disconnect the negative terminal first. Use a wrench, pliers, or another tool named in the driver's manual to loosen and remove the nut that's holding the negative terminal in place. Once the nut is removed, gently lift the terminal off the battery post.
