

What is a good adhesive for a capacitor?

The adhesive is needed to prevent the capacitor vibrating (the leads acting like a spring) and moving around when device is subject to external forces. I'm looking for something like DOW CORNING 744 WHITE Adhesive, RTV Silicone or WACKER Silicone Adhesive Sealants (WACKER Silicone Adhesive Sealants - Intertronics) Take a look at these options.

Is there Mercury in a capacitor?

I hope that it was not mercury! The capacitor is of a cylindric shape with two wires at bottom, about 7mm in diameter. It's the electrolyte. As far as I know there is no mercury involved. On wikipedia en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Electrolytic_capacitor you can find what are the most used electrolytes.

Can you use hot glue on silicone caps?

Ya, I tried hot glue before I posted. As soon as the caps (or the board in general) warms up the least little bit, the hot glue releases. Be aware that not all silicone sealants are compatible with electronics. If I remember correctly, the ones with a strong acetic acid smell are a no-no, because it will cause corrosion.

Can a capacitor cause a board to die?

What happens if you blow up a capacitor?

One capacitor won't do anything to your lungs/respiratory system... Like literally nothing. But if you blow up a cap due to overvoltage/reverse polarity (electrolytic)... hot material can fly at you so don't do that.

When adhesive amount is excessive, adhesive that overflows to the land area may cause poor soldering, conductivity, curing and/or alignment. If curing temperature and/or time is excessive, capacitor termination and board land surfaces might oxidize so much that adhesion strength and solderability of capacitors may deteriorate.
