

What is a capacitor & how does it work?

A capacitor is a passive device on a circuit board that stores electrical energy in an electric field by virtue of accumulating electric charges on two close surfaces insulated from each other. This is a list of known capacitor manufacturers, their headquarters country of origin, and year founded.

Why are capacitor manufacturers important?

The industry has faced significant challenges, such as the capacitor plague, which refers to a widespread failure of electrolytic capacitors, particularly in consumer hardware, that occurred in the early 2000s.

For coupling caps people often use Sprague Orange Drops 716p, these have copper leads and an outer foil which you can determine with an oscilloscope. Or Illinois Capacitor MPW series, they're also metalized polypropylene with copper leads and are likely the most popular choice for restoring McIntosh (just look at pictures of restored units, it's the yellow caps).

I used quite a few various coupling capacitors over the years. Sprague Orange Drop 715P, 716P, Sprague Vit

Q, Sprague Black Beauty, Russian FT-3 Teflon, Russian K40Y-9, REL Cap, Mundorf Supreme, Mundorf Silver/Oil, AuriCap, SoniCap Gen1 & Gen2, and a dozen others I do not remember at the moment.

Another good starting point is looking at the schematic of a known dev board and resist the temptation of thinking that all capacitors of the same nominal capacitance and package are interchangeable. Internal impedance changes from brand to brand, so if you "get inspired" by one board, stick to the exact brand and model of capacitors.

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
