

Solar energy stocks rise for three consecutive days

Why did solar energy stocks jump on Monday?

Shares of solar energy stocks jumped across the board on Monday, which happens to be a day before the U.S. presidential election. Of course, election speculation played a role in the move, but it's also not the only reason it happened, which I'll get to.

Is SolarEdge a good stock to buy?

The market sees this as a positive for SolarEdge's earnings potential because costs will be lower, but this is a warning to the industry overall. Third-quarter 2023 earnings results showed demand weakness across the solar energy market. That was due to California's net metering 3.0 policy, which made rooftop solar less economical.

Shares of residential solar stocks jumped early on Monday morning after SolarEdge Technologies (SEDG 8.10%) announced a major layoff. The industry has been under pressure for months, and this...
