Can the screws come out of the back plate?

The screws themselves should not be able to come out of the back plate anyways. you could try and ask a watchmaker, they do have specialized screw extractors for stripped screws in small sizes. Somewhere. Screw you, mate. Sounds like you're.... Screwed. I'll leave now.

How do I remove the screws from the back plate?

If they spin then its unscrewed just lift it up from both slits on the sides (near L and R triggers). The screws themselves should not be able to come out of the back plate anyways. you could try and ask a watchmaker, they do have specialized screw extractors for stripped screws in small sizes. Somewhere. Screw you, mate. Sounds like you're....

Can a laptop screw out from an angle?

However, you do sometimes get lucky. A lot of those thin laptops screw out from an angle on the sides, so this may be user induced if you had to do it from an angle :-). What I'd do first is try something like a pair of screw extracting pliers first before going to more drastic measures.

How do I unscrew the screws on my n3ds XL?

The screws on the new 3ds XL don't come out completely you just loosen them and pull the cover off. Have you tried wiggling the cover to see if it comes off? That screw might not be the kind that comes all the way out. I brought my N3DS to a watchmaker in my city and he was able to unscrew using one of his tools.

Do you lose a post if you open the rear panel?

Sadly, you usually lose the postas well if this is one of those aluminum skinned machines because it breaks when you try to get it out. However, you do sometimes get lucky.

So i know this is a dumb question but recently I opened the back panel of my G14(2021) and while I was unscrewing it I removed the captive screw because I thought it was stuck. I was able to open it but later I tried again only to realize that i could no longer use any tool to pry it open.

I have an Asus N53SV and I am trying to open up the laptop. I have unscrewed three of the four parts, but the fourth screw is in a hole and I can turn it, but it wont come out. I have tried using tape and rubber bands, but it wont come out. Anyone have ideas on how I should take the screw out of the laptop.

If you can't find it easily, it may be hidden behind a removable plate or panel that needs to be unscrewed with a screwdriver. Step 2: Remove the Plate or Panel. If your ...
