

Can a gas meter with a battery fail?

Both @wild666 and I were clearly referring to the general case of gas meters with batteries, and it's been established that they can fail and do strange things. The OP's meter is electronic and has a battery, so it may well be even more likely to misbehave if it can't phone home before it expires.

What happens if my smart meter battery fails?

A battery failure could result in a loss of supply in which case we'd schedule in an emergency same day appointment to make sure your supply is restored. Whilst we'd aim to replace your meter with another smart meter, during an emergency appointment this isn't always possible.

What happens if you don't spot a low battery meter?

So, if you don't spot the low battery and let the meter carry on, chances are it will fail completely. The daft thing is that the meters actually send low battery warnings to the smart network as an 'alert' message, but these are rarely actioned by suppliers. Usually, the user has to keep an eye on the meter and report a failing battery manually.

What should I do if my electric car battery goes bad?

Always use a charger recommended by your electric vehicle manufacturer. This will help avoid damage to the battery and ensure optimal charging speed. Avoid full discharge. Try to charge your battery when you can, rather than waiting until it's completely dead. This will reduce wear and extend its service life. Check the battery condition regularly.
